Trai Khai Pha 5 is a week-long program designed to allow Scouts at the Venturing level (ages 14 – 20) to experience new opportunities to test their skills and to meet other Scouts from across the country. This camp will offer several high adventure activities, Scoutcraft, shooting sports, water activities and much more! Trai Khai Pha is once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for Vietnamese-American youth to participate in a high-quality and exciting program.
