## Operation Kirara gives lifetime opportunity to Scouts

Through the solidarity fund "Operation Kirara," 101 Scouts and leaders from 18 countries in the Asia-Pacific Region set foot on the biggest camp and did not miss the experience of being part of the 23rd World Scout Jamboree.

The goal of the sponsorship is to promote international understanding and friendship and to enrich participants' Scouting experience through sharing of information and experience with other Scouts.

The Asia-Pacific Regional Support Centre collaborated with the Scout Association of Japan to sponsor the participation of Scouts and leaders from Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cambodia, Fiji, India, Indonesia, Maldives, Mongolia, Nepal, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand and even to potential member countries like Afghanistan, Myanmar, Timor Leste and Vietnam.

#### **NSO INITIATIVES**

### Mongolia: National Risk Management Workshop

The Scout Association of Mongolia (TSAM) organized the National Risk Management Workshop at the Scout Camp in Tuv Aimag, Mongolia, on 6-9 July 2015.

As a capacity building project of the Messengers of Peace initiative, 35 Scout leaders were equipped with knowledge and skills on risk management processes, risk probability and consequence, managing the risk for troop leaders, among others. TSAM is set to finalize its own National Risk Management Policy this year.

Ms. Uugantsetseg Gantumur of SAM was the Workshop Director with support from overseas resource persons: Aminur Rahman and Jamal Harim Bin Abdulla, members of APR Panel of Specialists; Mr. Ramakrishnan Ramasamy, Persekutuan Pengakap Malaysia Risk Management Committee chairman; and Malcolm Tan, APR Management Sub-Committee Chairman. SAM Secretary General Bayarjargal Damdindagva, APR Directors Prassanna Shrivastava and Syd Castillo provided the coordination and technical support.

### Sri Lanka to tie up with BOOKBRIDGE

Over recent years, Scouts' partnership with Bookbridge Foundation built learning centres for young people and rural communities in Mongolia and Cambodia. The project focuses on:

- creating an inviting learning environment (READ)
- developing activities that emphasize the importance of education (LEARN)
- offering courses that focus on life skills that can improve long-term career chances and income (EARN)

Sri Lanka is the third country where Bookbridge will start its operation in collaboration with Sri Lanka Scout Association, with a plan to formally sign the Memorandum of Understanding this year.
