I want to state how excited we are that the National Council BSA and the National Vietnamese Scouting Committee has selected Houston, Texas as the site for <u>your</u> 10th International Vietnamese Scouting Jamboree that will be held during the summer of 2014.

We look forward to having it here in Houston and will support you (National Council BSA), the organizing committee, and the activity to the extent that we can.

Thank you for your letter dated April 12. For purposes of complete understanding of our role, I have made comments to your letter and attached it to this email. Listed below are the key points about the role of the Sam Houston Area Council ("SHAC").

- SHAC is not the host of the 10th International Vietnamese Scouting Jamboree and has no ownership in it.
- SHAC will support you (National Council BSA), the organizing committee, and the activity to the extent that
 we can.
- SHAC will not process or handle any registration or funds for this National Council BSA activity.
- SHAC will make available its properties, other than Camp Strake, for consideration of the site for the 10th International Vietnamese Scouting Jamboree. If the National Council BSA and the organizing committee determine that either Bovay Scout Ranch or El Rancho Cima is the desired site for this activity, a contractual agreement will have to be made with National Council BSA for the rental of the camp, its facilities, and any service such as food that may be included.
 - The reason that Camp Strake is not being made available is because it is currently on the market for sale.

Other important items to note are:

- ALL BSA polices are expected by be followed by the organizing committee as it plans and conducts your 10th International Vietnamese Scouting Jamboree.
- No promotional information about the 10th International Vietnamese Scouting Jamboree will include information that gives the impression that SHAC is the host or has ownership in this National Council BSA activity.
- No fundraising will be conducted in SHAC by the National Council BSA, National Vietnamese Scouting Committee, or the organizing committee of the 10th International Vietnamese Scouting Jamboree to

subsidize this National Council BSA activity. Scouts in the SHAC through their units <u>may</u> conduct fundraising activities to support their program <u>if</u> the proper fundraising application is <u>submitted to</u> and <u>approved by SHAC</u>. This is to ensure that all BSA policies are followed.

Please continue to work through Chris Holt, our Deputy Scout Executive. Again, we are very excited to have this wonderful activity in Houston, Texas.
